

[ His Royal Highness will probably take this opportunity of laying before the Commission his views upon these points, and, after having heard those of the other Commissioners, will propose such Resolutions as he may think suitable. I have prepared for H.R.H.'s consideration a rough draft of Resolutions, together with a memorandum explanatory of my view in drawing them up.]

3. The Commission will consider the propriety of directing the publication of any statement for general information.

[ His Royal Highness will probably explain the grounds which render such a proceeding desirable, and will submit to the meeting the draft of such a statement. I have gone through that originally suggested by Mr. Cole, and as it is now ready for H.R.H.'s final revision.]

4. The Commission will consider the order in which it should take up the different questions that will come before it:

[ His Royal Highness might then, if he think it expedient, move that a reference be made to the Executive Committee to report upon any particular questions. I should think the two most important would be

(a) The Building question

(b) The Circular of Inquiries which will be addressed to local Commissioners when appointed. ]
