Lord Normanby to Colonel Phipps

Paris Nov^r 28th (1849)

My dear Charles

I have not time to say much to day but I must add one line in private to you on the subject of a dispatch which I have just written to say that I hear from several Members of the Jury to award the prizes of the late exhibition here that the Princes project and the liberal footing upon which he most judiciously placed it have produced the best possible impression amongst the manufacturing interest in France and may tend at least to weaken many inordinate prejudices.
