

Resolution passed unanimously
at a Meeting of the Deputation from
the Principal Towns in the Manu-
facturing Districts of England and
Scotland to the Royal Commission
at Westminster

June 28th 1850.

That this Meeting views with
considerable anxiety the discussion
which is going on as to the change
of the proposed site for the Building
for the Exhibition of 1851. as they are
of opinion that no spot can be
found combining so many ad-
vantages as that which has been
selected in Hyde Park.
