propose to the B. Commission that
Mr. Rogers be appointed to
cooperate with Mr. Reed for
the above mentioned purposes -

I had a long conversation with
Lord Stanton on the subject of our
Finances - He ~~took~~ a deep interest
in the subject, and would
write that the Commission should
make a statement to Parliament
on this subject, and put it to the
Nation what they wish us to do -
(I believe this course to be one of
the quickest). He thought that
allowing the Auditor to seek
